

Do You Have Fatty Liver?



The National Institutes of Health (NIH) Clinical Center seeks adults with non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD) or non-alcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH) to join a research study. Researchers want to learn which dose of vitamin E most effectively treats these conditions.

You may be eligible if you:

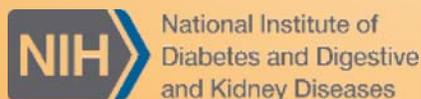
- Are 18 or older
- Have, or your physician suspects you have, non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD) or non-alcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH)

In the study:

- You will initially join a 12-week lifestyle modification program that includes exercise and diet
- You will receive treatment with vitamin E at one of three doses for up to three years
- Your participation will include thorough study of your liver disease
- You will make multiple visits to the NIH Clinical Center, including several inpatient visits
- Throughout the study, a registered dietitian will provide counseling to help you achieve and maintain the diet and lifestyle changes
- There is no charge for study-related tests, procedures, and medications
- Travel reimbursement may be provided
