

# Eczema (Atopic Dermatitis) Research Participants Needed



Doctors at National Institutes of Health (NIH) seek volunteers with eczema to participate in a research study. New research into the causes of atopic dermatitis suggests that differences in the skin bacteria may play a role in the disease. Researchers will collect live bacteria from the skin of healthy volunteers to treat adults and children suffering with atopic dermatitis.

## You or your loved one may participate in this study if:

- You are at least 7 years old
- Your doctor has made the diagnosis of atopic dermatitis
- Your rash involves your forearms or elbow area

## About the study:

- Blood test will be required for enrollment
- 6 visits to the NIH Clinical Center
- There is no cost for study-related test
- Financial compensation will be provided
