What is involved?

- A physical exam and blood test
- Traveling to the NIH Clinical Center at least 13 times for outpatient visits over the next year

To be eligible for this study, you must be:

- 18 to 50 years old and in good health
- Willing to participate in a trial where you will receive the investigational product

You may NOT be eligible if you:

- Are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding
- Weigh over 115 kg or 253 pounds
- Have a chronic medical condition such as diabetes, heart disease, or cancer
