

Researchers at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Clinical Center seek healthy men, 18-35 years old to participate in a research study. Doctors want to learn how the body burns energy at different temperatures. Compensation is provided.

During the study you will:

- Have a screening visit including medical history, physical exam, blood tests, and EKG.
- Have a 17-day inpatient stay at the NIH Clinical Center with weekends off.
- Stay in a temperature-controlled room and wear non-invasive devices to measure activity, heart rate, and temperature.
- Receive daily study medications (FDA-approved).

You may be eligible if you:

- Are male, 18-35 years old.
- Have a BMI of 18.5-25 kg/m2.


You may not be eligible if you

- Have a history of cancer, bariatric surgery, diabetes, or asthma.
- Smoke or use tobacco products.
