

Doctors at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) in Bethesda, Maryland, seek healthy volunteers to join a research study. Doctors are investigating the energy spent by the brain when you are performing certain tasks as well as resting. Participants will have a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and a positron emission tomography (PET) scan of the brain Participation involunteers.

emission tomography (PET) scan of the brain. Participation involves one screening and two outpatient visits for test and procedures.

You may be eligible if you are:

- At least 18 years old
- In good health

You may not participate if you:

- Are pregnant or breast feeding
- Use certain drugs such as marijuana or cocaine
- Have had a head trauma with a loss of consciousness for more than 30 minutes
- Are not able to have an MRI scan

Location: The NIH Clinical Center, America's research hospital, is located on the Metro red line in Bethesda, Maryland.

There is no charge for study-related tests and procedures. Compensation is provided.
